- 2. A review of proposed wetland and buffer project for Eversource 141 Ocean Rd Greenland by Conor Madison Project Manager from GZA was reviewed and the following motion made by Alice 2nd by Bill to recommend the work scope as proposed. Passed
- 3. A report of the Town's open and conservation spaces Monitor Phoenix LaFlamme-Howe. A review of the properties and no changes were made except, it was recommended that the selectmen need a grate installed on an open well on the Moulton Ave property.
- 4. Motion by Alice 2nd by Kathleen to expend \$2400 from the Conservation Warrant to mulch the original trail of the Greenland Greenways, Passed. A budget for maintaining the trails has not been completed and should be at the next meeting.
- 5. Kathleen will arrange for a 15-minute presentation "Pollinator Pathways". With the reduction of honeybee populations, the Commission is exploring the expansion of the trail system along the south side of the field. It is felt this would be an easy trail to walk, demonstrating plants that would be beneficial for bees, along with demonstrations of bee keeping.
