

BLIND EXEMPTION (RSA 72:37)

A property owner who is legally blind as determined by the Department of Education, Bureau of Services for Blind and Visually Impaired, shall be exempt each year on the assessed value, for property tax purposes, of his or her residential real estate to the value of \$15,000.

- New applications must be submitted to the Town Administrator by April 01 of the tax year in which you apply.
- You must qualify as of April 01 of the tax year in which you apply.
- A certification letter from Department of Education, Bureau of Services for Blind and Visually Impaired, must also be submitted with the application.
