

## ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ORDINANCE

Town of Greenland, NH

Section 1-1 Authority - In accordance with the authority granted by Chapter 31:39 as amended, and any other applicable chapter or amendment thereto of the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated, 1971.

Section 1-2 Possession of Alcoholic Beverages - It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to possess any alcoholic beverage, with the seal broken, while in or out of any vehicle, or upon a public highway, or while upon any sidewalk or common, or upon any school owned property within the limits of the Town of Greenland.

Section 1-3 Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages - It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to consume any alcoholic beverage, while in or out of any vehicle, or upon a public highway, or while upon any sidewalk or common, or upon any school owned property within the limits of the Town of Greenland.

Section 1-4 Penalty - Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a violation and upon conviction there of shall be liable to a penalty of not less than, twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for each of offense, nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

Section 1-5 Authority - The Chief of Police of the Town of Greenland and his duly appointed agents, are hereby authorized to summons and prosecute in the Court having jurisdiction thereof, any, person, firm or corporation deemed to be in violation of this ordinance.

Section 1-6 Validity - If any section or part of a section of this article is declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, it shall in no way be held to invalidate or impair the validity, or effect of any other section, or part of a section, or paragraph of this article.

Section 1-7 Permit Variance - A permit may be obtained for variance of Sections 1-2 and 1-3 from the Chief of Police.
