## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Fill forms out in pencil so that changes (i.e. Medications) can easily be made when necessary. Print legibly.
- 2. Fill out all information that applies.
- 3. Remember to include any allergies you may have.
- 4. After the forms are complete, fold them back up and place them back in the vial.
- 5. The vial is placed on the inside of the refrigerator on the upper shelf, right-hand corner. A piece of Velcro on the side and one on the vial will help it stay in place, or it can be put in the door, top shelf. If you don't have a Vial, a plastic Ziploc bag can be used.
- 6. The other label is then placed on the outside of the refrigerator.
