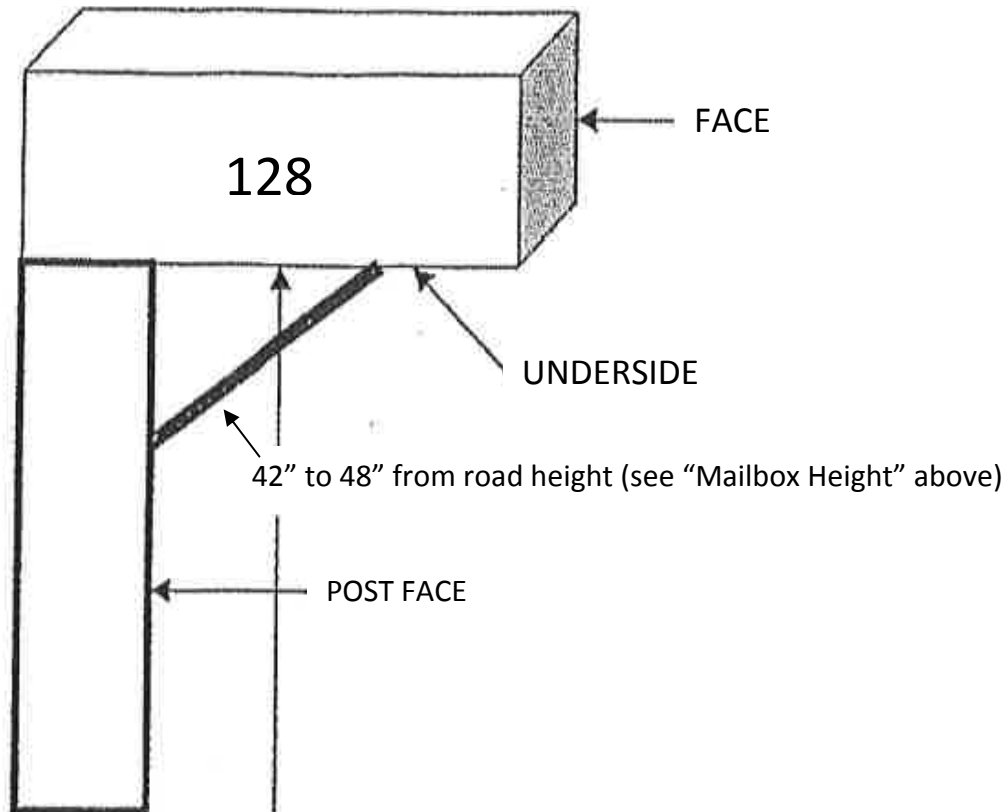


## MAILBOX GUIDELINES

- **Face of Mailbox:** Not less than 48" from edge of pavement.
- **Mailbox Post:** Not less than 60" from edge of pavement; must be neat and of adequate strength and size.
- **Mailbox Height:** To be 42" to 48" from road height to the underside surface of the mailbox. NOTE: If mailbox has a brace, it must be 42" to 48" from road height.
- **House Number:** Painted or stenciled no less than 2" high on mailbox OR post, both sides.
- **It's the homeowner's responsibility to keep the mailbox approach open:**
  - Keep driving surface passable and level with the street pavement; it should be gravel, cinders or stone (if not asphalt or concrete).
  - Keep driving surface clear of ice and snow.



*The Contractor shall perform all services with good workmanship and is solely responsible for damage directly caused by work performed. Damage to mailboxes, residential lawns, irrigation systems, etc. shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the property owner, time being of the essence, if the damage is determined to be intentional or caused by negligence on the part of the Contractor.*
